Personal data protection¹ consent form

Photographs and/or video recordings of participants are in no way mandatory. The European Parliament undertakes to respect the image rights of persons who do not give their consent. As data placed on the Internet can be downloaded freely, and it is impossible to monitor the use made of the data by third parties, you may choose not to allow the taking of images and their distribution.
